## ABC in Winter



<b>Friday</b>	4 courts in Bockenheim	4 courts in <a href="#">Bockenheim</a>

## Money for Netting & Stands

## Membership fees in 2021

At our annual members' meeting, we decided to change the way we would collect membership fees. As of January 2021, we will start **charging your bank accounts for the next 6 months in advance**. That is to say, if you are a member paying full fees, your account will be debited 120 EUR at the beginning of January (20 EUR per month, times 6 months).

The next half-year instalment will be due at the beginning of July and so on...

What **will not change** yet is when you can **cancel your membership at ABC**. So you will still be able to quit the club at the end of every financial quarter (March 31st, June 30th etc), provided you have given us at least one month's notice. Thus, if you quit at the end of March, you will receive a refund of half the amount you paid in January - 60 EUR for a full membership. Aligning the membership duration and the fee collection to both conform to the half-year rhythm is something we want to do at the next Members' meeting, early in 2021!

The **short-term membership** option still exists but we've changed it so there is only a one-month short term membership option for 40 EUR.
